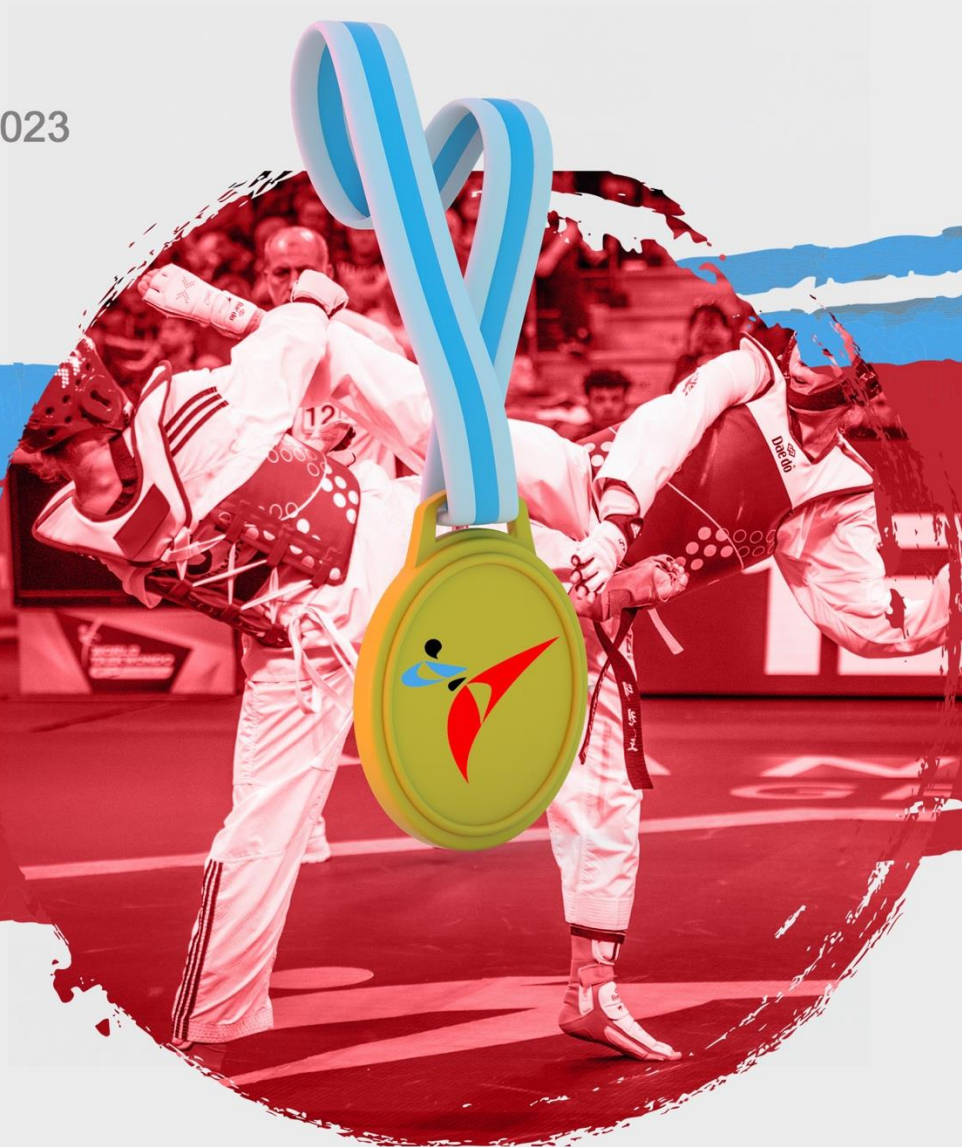

This Handbook is designed to provide PATU athletes with a summary of information needed to participate successfully and in the fairest way in the coming years.

1. APPLICABLE CHAMPIONSHIPS



5 Official events selected, promoted and organized by PATU obtaining an equal Rank of points for the 5 P10 qualifying events. PATU reserves the rights and decision of the scoring events.

2. OBTAINING PATU RANKING

2.1 RANKING CATEGORIES

The PATU U22 ranking will only affect the categories that will comprise those born between 2004 to 2009.

GENERAL RULES

- **Ranking PANAM SERIES SUB 22 aims for a fair qualification for the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games, beginning in Queretaro and has different rules than the PATU Ranking for Kids, Cadets & Juniors.**
- The Ranking will consist of 4 men's and 4 women's weights.
- All competitors will obtain points for a fight won, position obtained and participation (will be consider participation if the athlete passed the weigh-in fight at least one match).
- In order to obtain direct qualification by ranking points to the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games, it will be mandatory to participate in a minimum of 4 of the 5 events to obtain points.
- A maximum of 8 competitors will qualify: 6 per PATU Ranking, 1 per wildcard, 1 host.
- The qualifying events will be held in OPEN format with the respective authorization of the MNA/PATU.
- In the event of a tie on points, the best result of the last event will prevail.
- There is no point carryover: if you compete in another weight you will start at 0 points.
- The classifications will be nominal and non-transferable.
- There will be no limit to the number of athletes registered per country.
- Host Country will be entitled to a place as long as they compete in 1 of 5 events.
- The ranking positions of the qualifying process will be taken into account for seeding at the Junior Pan American Games 2025.
- **Host Country that has classified a competitor will have seeded number 4 if it does not have better ranking AND HAS COMPLIED WITH THE PARTICIPATION RULES.**
- **20 points will be awarded for participating, 10 points for a fight won and 100 points for first place, decreasing by 0.602% for each place below the First Place (see point 6.1 of the ranking rules)**

4. CLASSIFICATION FORMULA

A: The points obtained according to Rank (4.1) and Level (5.1) in the different PATU recognized events

4.1 Rank

It is the classification that is given to a competitor according to the result and the Level of the event, which can award more or less points for the ranking.

5. LEVELS

The level of events will be as follows::

Level	Patu 22 Qualification Events
P10	Patu 22 Ranking Events

6. POINTS ASSIGNMENT

6.1 Assigning points by Rank (explanatory example):

- Event P10, 1st position athlete receives 100 points.
- The 2nd position athlete receives 60% of the points awarded to the 1st position athlete (ex. 60 points)
- The 3rd position athletes will receive 60% of the points awarded to the 2nd position athlete (ex. 36 points)
- 5th place athletes will receive 60% of the points awarded to the 3rd positioned athletes. /ex. 21.6 points)
- The 9th positioned athletes will receive 60 % of the points awarded to the 5th positioned athletes (ex. 13 points) and the same rule of 60% will apply to the following places.
- Points will be two decimal places
- Points will be awarded according to the position of the event Rank held according to the following table:

6.2 General Rules

All competitors will be given 20 points just for participating and it will be necessary to perform at least one match to be awarded the points per Rank in that championship, including the participation points.

Everyone will have their score with accordance to their position according to the table in Article 6.1 whether they win or lose their first fight.

For each match won you will get 10 extra points for the ranking of that championship, the competitors who fight are not counted as won fights.

All competitors who fight will obtain the corresponding points, regardless of the number of countries participating in each weight division.

There will be no points for competitors who do not have an opponent in their weight division, to receive any points it is necessary to perform at least one match.

6.3 Weight Division Point Drag

There won't be drag of point per weight division. When a competitor changes their weight division they will start from 0.

At the first event, where the change of the weight division happens, the athlete will start with 0 point. But the 100% of the point awarded in this new weight division will be updated at the next issue of the rankings

6.4 Category Point Drag

Carrying forward points from any other category or PATU ranking is not allowed.

6.5 Validation of Points

The points will be valid until the Asunción **2025 Junior Pan American Games**.

Deduction will be made once the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games are over.

6.6 Application of Points

- The Organizing Committee will submit the tournaments report (template provided by the OVR) to the PATU Secretariat within one week after the end of the relevant tournament..
- Ranking points will only be applied when the Technical Delegate approves the official results and sends the official results to the PATU no later than two (2) days after the end of the tournament.

6.7 Cancellation of Ranking Points

The sanctions are proposed by the Technical Director of the event in writing and approved by the PATU Ranking technical commission and will be for decision making interpreting the WT regulations/PATU Ranking Regulations, following its principles of fairness and equality.

If a competitor is sanctioned, he may lose the points obtained in the championship and be penalized with the impossibility of attending any other event scoring for the ranking, depending on the decision of the technical commission based on the seriousness of the Facts.

If a competitor does not pass the Random, they will not earn that event's ranking points for participation.

6.8 Tie-Breaking Criteria

Best position in a higher level event. EXAMPLE:There are 5 championships that give 100 points to the first place (the 5 are of higher level), it will be obtained by the competitor with the best position in any of the 5 events. If a competitor scored 1st place in an event and in another event scored 3rd place, then whoever finished first in one of those championships will be better classified in the ranking.

If the two competitors have finished 1st in any of these championships (the tie persists), they will be the ones with the best result in the last event of the ranking.

If the tie persists, the ranking will belong competitor who participated in the most championships(of all levels)

If the tie persists: the technical commission will establish a solution for the tiebreaker.

7. UPDATES OF POINTS

7.1 Ranking Update Rules

- The ranking Will be publish once a month.
- IN CASES NOT ESPECIFIED IN THIS RULES, THE PATU TECHNICAL COMMITTEE WILL DECIDE. THEY RESOLUTION ARE FINAL AND UNDISPUTABLE.
- In the case that there is a mistake in the ranking position, after 5 days has passed since the issue of the monthly ranking. The correction Will be shown at the following month.
- The ranking Will be publish at the end of each event even if the month has not finish.

9. COMPETITOR SEEDING

9.1 Seeding

- The seeding rate will be 100%
- In the case that the athletes seeding are not eligible to participate (meaning: is no register, does not the weigh in or no show up), the next ranked athlete or the best ranked athlete will be seeding in the position. At the first event, all the athlete Will be seeding randomly.

10. AMENDMENT

These bylaws can be amendment from time to time with the approval of the PATU Council.
