

5. **REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. In accordance with Article 4: Competitor Qualification of the WT Rules of Competition, the competitor must:
- 2. Nationality holder of the participating team.
- 3. Be a Taekwondo Black Belt.
- 4. WT 2023 Global Athlete License (GAL).
- 5. All coaches must have WT Level 1 certification (minimum).
- 6. All coaches must be 21 years of age or older.







6. DRESS CODE:

Formal dress is mandatory for all coaches during the semifinals and finals.

7. AFFILIATES:

Each participant must have citizenship of the country he/she represents. They must have a letter of endorsement from their respective National Federation.

8. COMPETITION GEAR:

The OC will provide the electronic chest and head protectors, each athlete must bring their own electronic insoles to compete, all athletes are responsible for bringing their own competition equipment. All athletes must enter the competition area with their WT approved competition equipment and uniforms. Genital, shin and forearm protectors must be inside the uniform. No items other than helmets may be worn on the head. Any religious items must be approved in advance and worn inside the helmet and uniform and must not cause injury or obstruction to the opponent.

9. OFFICIAL UNIFORM:

All athletes must wear a WT / Pan American Taekwondo Union (PATU) approved white V-neck uniform in good condition. Logos, Team names, Country, Athlete's name, will be allowed under WT uniform rules. Only the following will be allowed. Uniforms approved by WT, Panamerican Taekwondo Union (PATU)

10. AGE & DIVISIONS:

- Cadets: 2011, 2012 or 2013
- Junior: 2008, 2009 or 2010
- Senior: 2008 or before

11. RANKING:

World G3 (Senior Kyorugi)

Panamerican Ranking P8

12. COMPETITION RULES:

13. COMPETITION METHOD:

Single elimination system, best of 3 rounds; No entry limit in each division; Times can ONLY be adjusted by the WT TD (Technical Delegate);

14. TIMES:

Best of 3 rounds system Senior (2 minutes x 2 or 3 rounds x 1 minute interval) Junior (2 minutes x 2 or 3 rounds x 1 minute interval) Cadet (1.5 minutes x 2 or 3 rounds x 1 minute interval)

18. CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATING TEAMS:

Round-trip airfare, lodging, food and transportation expenses will be paid by the participant or their respective MNA. Lodging in official hotels is not mandatory.

No transportation of any kind will be provided by the Organizing Committee.

19. WT GLOBAL LICENSE AND ONLINE REGISTRATION:

- WT Global License Registration. All athletes and team officials must first be registered with a WT Global Athlete License (GAL) OR a WT Global Official License (GOL).
- Online registration in the WT (Simply Compete).
- Registration is only possible with a valid WT Global License.







20. TECHNICAL REGISTRATION:

- WT Global License Registration. All team officials must first have a WT Global License. All team officials must first be registered with a WT Global Official License (GOL).
- WT online registration (Simply Compete).
- All technicians must be at least 18 years old.
- All technicians must have WT Coach at least Level 1.

21. REGISTRATION FEES:

The Organizing Committee shall collect the registration fees in dollars upon registration at the competition venue, no other type of payment will be accepted. Registered athletes and coaches will not be allowed to participate in the competition without payment. The Organizing Committee has a NO REFUND policy under any circumstances. Registration will take place at the Best Western Irazú Hotel according to the event schedule.

22. NO SHOW POLICY:

Athletes who do not show up for registration and have not previously notified that they will not participate in the event before the early registration deadline, must pay their registration fee. Cancellations will only be accepted with a medical certificate after this date, if there is no legal medical document, the corresponding payment must be made by February 25, 2024.

23. INTERNATIONAL REFEREES

PATU will appoint the International Referees. The appointed international referees shall act in the President's Cup 2025; the following conditions apply: a. International Referees must pay their own round-trip airfare.

24. TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND COMPETITION SUPERVISORY BOARD (CSB):

WT/PATU shall appoint 1 (one) Technical Delegate and up to 5 (five) persons to the Competition Supervisory Board (CSB).

25. TECHNICAL MEETING

The Team Leader meeting shall be held 1 (one) day before the start of the activities of each type of competition. See general schedule for details.

26. PSS SYSTEM: DAE DO

27. INFORMATION & SERVICES:

INSURANCE:

• The respective national taekwondo associations and/or teams must ensure that all officials and participants have effective medical and travel insurance coverage.

All participants must sign the liability waiver upon registration.

28. HOTEL:

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See the Accommodation Guide available on WT's Simply Compete.

29. TRANSPORTATION:

The OC will only provide transportation for Referees and Staff.

Transportation of teams, athletes and coaches will be at their own expense







30. VISA INFORMATION:

Visa recommendation letters will be generated by the Organizing Committee. The deadline to apply for a visa is January 15, 2025. Email eventstkdcr@gmail.com with a copy of your valid passport and proof of registration to obtain a visa invitation letter.

31. MEDICAL-CARE:

The OC will provide medical care only in case of emergency when a participant is injured. Participants will be responsible for all expenses incurred for injuries and/or hospitalization. The OC recommends the participant to have his/her medical insurance and to have all documents at hand.
