1. Eligibility.

- ✓ Holder of National Certificate and/or Kukkiwon 1st Dan or higher.
- ✓ Recommendation by the national member association (MNA/Federation) to which the applicant belongs.
- ✓ National Referee Certificate and/or current PATU credential.
- ✓ 21 years of age or older (age is calculated according to the year in which the seminar is held).
- ✓ Certificate of approval of the theoretical course.

Refresher Seminar, you must have your complete IPET profile including the theory course with passing grade.

The minimum participation quota for the seminar is “20” registered participants.
Maximum registration capacity will be according to the capacity on site indicated by the host and up to 130 people.

7. Equipment

All participants must attend with sports clothes (pants & jacket) or dobok, tennis shoes or Taekwondo training shoes. Bring Material for taking notes.

NOTE: no open toe shoes will be allowed/sandals or shorts.

8. Waiver

By registering for the Pan-American Coaches Seminar, all participants agree to the rules and regulations of participation established by the Organizing Committee. All participants will participate at their own risk. The Organizer is not responsible for any loss or damage to anyone or any equipment under any circumstances.

9. Evaluation Criteria

- ✓ On-Line Course 50% of the certification. The applicant must complete all the content available on the platform (poomsae and kyorugui) and take the evaluation obtaining a minimum of 70 points of correct answers in order to participate in the on-site seminar.
- ✓ Face-to-Face Seminar 50% of the certification. The applicant must register according to the bases described in this document, prior approval of the online course.

At the end of the on-site seminar, the applicant will be given a practical evaluation and must obtain at least 70 points out of 100 on average to pass the practical exam.

Written notification of the results of the examination will be sent to the relevant National Association or Federation within one week of the end of the classroom course.

If you fail any part of the exam, you will have 1 opportunity to retake the exam. In this case, you will have to take the exam on the next working date in the calendar of activities.

10. Certificate

Upon satisfactory completion of both evaluations (theoretical and practical) (70 points or more), the referee will have a credential with the number that identifies him/her in the Pan American Referees list, which will qualify him/her as eligible to participate in the different events of the exclusive PAN AMERICAN circuit.
